Introduction:

The Center for New Learning of the University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh maintains an educational partnership with Fox Valley Technical College (FVTC), to provide a baccalaureate degree completion program articulating transfer from the above-referenced Associate Degrees to the Bachelor of Liberal Studies degree with an emphasis in Organizational Administration (BLS/OA).

The attached credit transfer grids represent updates to previously established Agreements for these curricula. All of the programs in question have retained their essential features, and these updates represent only minor changes within FVTC and/or UW Oshkosh BLS/OA programs.

Conditions:

- The terms of transfer of this program-to-program articulation agreement apply only for the purposes of entry to the **BLS/OA degree program** at UW-Oshkosh. FVTC students seeking admission to other degree programs on the UW-Oshkosh campus may transfer to the University only those credits recognized under the current UW System – WTCS Transfer Guidelines. FVTC students admitted to

UW-Oshkosh under the terms of this articulation agreement who subsequently elect to pursue a degree and major other than the BLS/OA degree program, will find the extended transfer of FVTC credit does not apply outside of this program.

- Students from FVTC must have successfully completed one of the Associate degrees referenced above (fulfilling all course work stipulated in the appended grids) with a graduating grade point average of a 2.5 or higher for consideration for transfer under the terms of the articulation document. The terms of the articulation agreement do **not** apply to FVTC students who have completed only a portion of the required course work for these Associate degrees.

Transfer of Credit:

- The BLS/OA program at UW-Oshkosh accepts as block credit in transfer the Technical Area courses and courses that meet UW-Oshkosh requirements and electives to meet the 120-credit minimum graduation requirement. Please see attached.
- Additional course work completed in the area of general education will be accepted in transfer on a course-by-course equivalency basis as detailed in appendices of this document.
- This agreement abides by UW System policy to transfer a maximum of 72 credits earned at two-year institutions to University of Wisconsin baccalaureate degree programs.

Effective Date:

This agreement is effective with retroactive application as of July 1, 2006.
