Purpose: To facilitate articulation between the Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS) Early Childhood Education AAS programs and the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh (UWO) Elementary Education Program (certification in Pre-Kindergarten-Grade Three and Pre-Kindergarten-Grade Six, BS).

Wisconsin Technical College System students who successfully complete an Associate of Applied Science degree after July 1, 2001 in Early Childhood Education (Wisconsin Technical College System statewide core curriculum) wishing to transfer to University of Wisconsin Oshkosh will be awarded the following credits toward a BS degree in Elementary Education (certification in Pre-Kindergarten-Grade Three and Pre-Kindergarten-Grade Six).

General Requirements:

- Students transferring General Education Courses from Wisconsin Technical College System to University of Wisconsin Oshkosh may transfer a maximum of 15 credits of General Education, Communication, Behavioral Science, and Social Science courses.
- Students may transfer a total of two courses from the Math and/or Natural Science areas, if the courses were taken September 1995 or later.
- The maximum number of semester credits that can be transferred from two-year collegiate institutions to University of Wisconsin Oshkosh is 72.

Admission Requirements for the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh:

- 1) Acceptance into the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh Professional Education Program is based upon academic and non-academic criteria determined by the College of Education and Human Services.
- 2) The University of Wisconsin Oshkosh baccalaureate candidate must also meet University of Wisconsin Oshkosh's General Education Requirements.
- 3) Program-to-Program transfer courses/credits are accepted only for the degree specified in this Early Childhood Program.
- 4) Course equivalencies specified in this articulation agreement are subject to change in the event that the course curriculum of the Wisconsin Technical College System Early Childhood Program or University of Wisconsin Oshkosh undergoes revision.
- 5) Degree must be posted on official transcript to receive credits from the agreement.

Admission Requirements for the College of Education and Human Services Professional Education Program:

- 1) Admission to University of Wisconsin Oshkosh does NOT guarantee admission to the Professional Education Program in the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh College of Education and Human Services. To be eligible to apply for admission to the College of Education and Human Services Professional Education Program, students must meet the following conditions:
 - a) Completion of 40 credits towards the degree (transferable Wisconsin Technical College System plus University of Wisconsin Oshkosh credits).
 - b) 2.75 cumulative grade point average on transferable credits (it must be emphasized that 2.75 GPA is the minimum and does not guarantee acceptance into the Professional Education Program).
 - c) Attend a Professional Education Program Orientation Meeting.
 - d) Pass all three portions of the Pre-Professional Skills Test (PPST).

- e) Pass (with "C"/"S" or better) in Speech 110 (or equivalent).
- 2) **Admission I Portfolio items will be due in a portfolio during the semester that you take Individual School & Society or Sophomore Practicum. Specific directions, forms, and timelines will be distributed during class at the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh.**

This agreement is effective July 1, 2001 and will apply to students who complete a Wisconsin Technical College System Early Childhood Education Associate of Applied Science degree after that date.
