Your UW Oshkosh Email account is extremely important. Email is considered an official method for communicating with University of Wisconsin Oshkosh students because it delivers information in a convenient, timely, cost effective, and environmentally aware manner. The University expects that email communications will be received and read by students in a timely fashion. Students are expected to check their UW Oshkosh official email account on a regular and frequent basis. *The University recommends checking your UW Oshkosh email at least twice per week.*

Your UW Oshkosh email address will be the first 5 letters of your last name, the first letter of your first name, and the last two digits of your student ID number. To verify your username, search the On-line Directory at: <http://www.acs.uwosh.edu/wpsearch.php>

Your initial password for your student email account is your seven-digit UW Oshkosh student ID number. You must change your initial password and set a new, personalized password before you can check your email.
