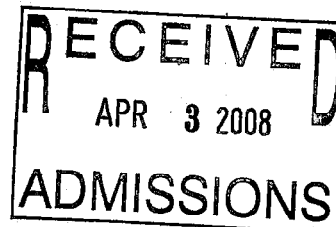

Introduction:

Effective Fall semester 2008, the Department of Special Education, College of Education & Human Services of the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh recognizes an educational partnership with the Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS) with regard to graduates of the Associate of Applied Science Degree Program in Instructional Assistant. This Agreement will provide a bachelor's degree completion program articulating transfer to the Bachelor of Science in Education degree program in Special Education Cross Categorical (BSE-SE)(middle childhood through early adolescence and/or early adolescence through adolescence).

Rationale:

The Associate of Applied Science Degree Program in Instructional Assistant prepares individuals to work directly with students under the supervision of a licensed teacher. The duties of an instructional assistant include assisting children with math, reading, and writing assignments as well as handling classroom management, clerical and other tasks related to instruction. This program meets Title I and No Child Left Behind Act paraeducator requirements. Many graduates of this program are employed as paraeducators in special education classrooms serving students with various disabilities. Therefore, many graduates of the Associate of Applied Science Degree Program in Instructional Assistant may be naturally interested in continuing their education to become a special education teacher. Graduates of this Associate degree program will find the curriculum of the Special Education Cross Categorical Program, with its coursework in general education, educational foundations, elementary and secondary education, reading, and special education, a valuable addition to their previous coursework within the Wisconsin Technical College System. The underlying assumption for this articulation agreement between the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh and the Wisconsin



Technical College System is the recognition of an academic partnership wherein the technical college campuses provide some of the general education, pre-professional education, and special education courses and the University provides expanded general education courses as well as the upper level pre-professional education and special education courses required within the Bachelor of Science in Education degree program in Special Education Cross Categorical (middle childhood through early adolescence and/or early adolescence through adolescence).

Conditions:

- The terms of transfer of this program-to-program articulation agreement apply only for the purposes of entry to the Bachelor of Science in Education degree program in Special Education Cross Categorical (middle childhood through early adolescence and/or early adolescence through adolescence) at UW Oshkosh. Students from the Wisconsin Technical College System seeking admission to other degree programs offered at UW Oshkosh may transfer to the University only those credits recognized under the current UW System - WTCS Transfer Guidelines as documented on the Transfer Information System web site at: <http://www.uwsa.edu/tis/>. Wisconsin Technical College System students admitted to UW Oshkosh under the terms of this articulation agreement who subsequently elect to pursue a degree and major other than the Bachelor of Science in Education degree program in Special Education Cross Categorical (middle childhood through early adolescence and/or early adolescence through adolescence) will find the extended transfer of credit does not apply outside of the BSE-SE cross categorical program.
- Students from the WTCS must have completed the above-named Associate of Applied Science degree program (fulfilling all course work stipulated in the appropriate appended credit transfer grid) with a graduating grade point average of 2.75 or higher for consideration for transfer under the terms of this articulation document. The terms of the articulation agreement do not apply to WTCS students who have completed only a portion of the required course for the Associate of Applied Science degree program named above.

Transfer of Credit

- The Bachelor of Science in Education degree program in Special Education Cross Categorical (middle childhood through early adolescence and/or early adolescence through adolescence) at UW Oshkosh accepts in transfer the general education, pre-professional education, and special education courses stipulated within the appended credit transfer grid for the Associate of Applied Science Degree Program in Instructional Assistant.
- This agreement abides by UW System policy to transfer a maximum of 72 credits earned at two-year institutions to University of Wisconsin baccalaureate degree programs.

Effective Date:

This agreement is effective with the start of the Fall 2008 semester at UW Oshkosh (September 2, 2008).
