

FALL 2018 CHECKLIST

Congratulations on your admission to UW Oshkosh for fall 2018! Hang on to this document. It has key information and deadlines necessary for keeping you on track to being a registered Titan at UW Oshkosh!

SCHEDULE AN ADVISEMENT AND REGISTRATION DAY AND SUBMIT YOUR \$100 DEPOSIT

An email will be sent to the account listed on your application. Using the link provided in the email, choose an Advisement and Registration* day and submit your \$100 tuition deposit** online. The deposit is a credit toward your fall tuition and is refundable with a written request postmarked no later than **May 1, 2018**.

* A state-issued ID will be required for your Advisement and Registration day. If you do not have a driver's license, military ID, state ID or passport, please visit <http://wisconsindot.gov/Pages/dmv/license-drvs/how-to-apply/id-card.aspx> for info on how to obtain a state ID.

** If the tuition deposit poses a financial hardship for you, please contact the Admissions Office.

CHECK YOUR NEW TITAN EMAIL OFTEN

When we receive your \$100 deposit, a Titan email account will be created for you. Login information for this account will be mailed to you within five business days. More detailed information regarding Advisement and Registration will be sent **by email** around **April 15, 2018**. Please check your email often throughout the year.

APPLY FOR HOUSING AND DINING PLANS

The \$100 tuition deposit will also grant you access to the online housing portal to apply for housing and dining plans. Steps on how to access the housing portal will be included in the Titan email account mailing mentioned previously.

Within the housing portal, you will submit a \$150 housing prepayment, which, after a \$25 administrative fee, will be used as a credit toward your spring 2019 housing charges. The \$125 prepayment is refundable with written notification postmarked no later than **June 15, 2018**.

New student room selection for fall 2018 will take place from **June 25-29, 2018**. Move-in day for first-year students is **Sunday, Sept. 2, 2018**.

According to the UW System Board of Regents Housing Policy:

Those freshman and sophomore students (students who have not earned 48 or more credits, or lived on campus for four semesters as of the first day of class, fall 2018, who are not veterans, married, or living with parent(s) or legal guardian(s), within 45 miles of UW Oshkosh are required to live in a university-operated residence hall when such accommodations are available. Students are exempt if they have reached the age of 21 by the first day of class.

If you live within the 45-mile commuter range and are commuting from your parent or legal guardian's permanent home, you must request and complete a commuter card from the Department of Residence Life.

SUBMIT YOUR FAFSA AND APPLY FOR SCHOLARSHIPS

File the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.ed.gov as soon as possible after **October 1, 2017** to be considered for financial aid. The UWO school code is **003920**. The priority filing date at UWO is **Dec. 15, 2017**.

Scholarships for UW Oshkosh students are available via our scholarship search tool, "Academic Works." To search scholarships and match your qualifications to available awards, visit uwosh.edu/go/scholarships. Most scholarships have a deadline of **4:30 p.m. CDT on Friday, Jan. 12, 2018** unless otherwise noted.

REQUEST ACCOMMODATIONS

If you are in need of accommodations, our Accessibility Services Coordinator will work with you to ensure access to programs and services at UW Oshkosh. It is important to submit accommodation requests at your earliest convenience. You can request accommodations online at admissions.uwosh.edu/accessibility-center-request.

COMPLETE YOUR PLACEMENT TESTS

In March, April or May, you must complete the English and math placement tests, unless you have taken a transferable college-level course in that area (see wisconsin.edu/transfer to check). Optional foreign language placement tests are offered in French, Spanish and German. Sign up information for regional placement tests will be emailed to you around **Feb. 1, 2018**. Testing should be completed at least two weeks prior to your Advisement and Registration day.

APPLY FOR PARKING

If you're living in the residence halls, you will be sent a parking permit application from the Parking Services Office in early July 2018. The deadline to apply to request a parking permit is **July 31, 2018**. Students living on campus are not guaranteed parking permits, as they are granted through a lottery system. Commuter student parking is guaranteed.

Your statement of account (bill) is only available online in late summer through your electronic TitanWeb account. You will be notified via your Titan email when your billing statement is available. Your statement will include tuition, room/board and other fees. Please print/submit a copy with your payment.
